All the facts about your purchase (of a product or a service) including the place you did the purchase from, and the date on which you brought the product you are complaining about should be included.

Describe the problem clearly and state what you want to be done about it.

WORKSHEET – 4 (Exponents)

Subject: Mathematic

Expanded Form:

We can express a large number in terms of 10's.

Ex: let a number is 35246

Here, 3 is at ten thousand place, 5 is at thousand place, 2 is at hundred place, 4 is at 10 tenth place and 6 is at unit place.

So, 35246 can be written as

$$35246 = 3 \times 10000 + 5 \times 1000 + 2 \times 100 + 4 \times 10 + 6 \times 1$$

$$= 3 \times 10^4 + 5 \times 10^3 + 2 \times 10^2 + 4 \times 10^1 + 6 \times 10^0$$

[Note $10,000 = 10^4$, $1000 = 10^3$, $100 = 10^2$, $10 = 10^1$ and $1 = 10^0$]

Let us expand another number.

$$250374 = 2 \times 100000 + 5 \times 10000 + 0 \times 1000 + 3 \times 100 + 7 \times 10 + 4 \times 1$$

$$= 2 \times 10^5 + 5 \times 10^4 + 0 \times 10^3 + 3 \times 10^2 + 7 \times 10^1 + 4 \times 10^0$$

$$= 2 \times 10^5 + 5 \times 10^4 + 3 \times 10^2 + 7 \times 10^1 + 4 \times 10^0$$

Expressing Large Number in The Standard Form

Any number can be expressed as a decimal number between 1.0 and 10.0 including 1.0 multiplied by a power of 10. Such a form of a number is called its standard form.

Example 1: Let a number is 3500

So, $3500 = 3.5 \times 10^3$ is the standard form of the number 3500

Example 2: Let a number is 12756000

So, $12756000 = 1.2756 \times 10^7$ is the standard form of the number 12756000.
