To ensure that, here are a few important points to be noted for the session 2023-24.

- **The school reopens on Wednesday, 5th April’23.**
- **School timings for the respective classes:**
Pre-Primary: 8.30am-1.00pm
Classes I to XII: 7:30am-2:00pm
- **Pre-primary to class V will have a five day working week (Saturday off).**
- **School timings for working Saturdays : 7:30am to 1:00pm**
- **All the students should reach school before 7:30 a.m.**
- Attendance at school, along with regularity and punctuality, is a must and students should be encouraged to follow the same diligently.
- A written application should be furnished by the absentees stating the reason for their absenteeism.
- Students are not allowed to leave during regular school hours; in case of emergency, a written note, duly signed by the parent stating the reason for exemption, will be needed.
- If your child is going to be absent for more than 2 days then please ensure that you send a leave note to class teacher. Avoid leaves unless it is very urgent.
- As per the school policy, every student should have mandatory 75% attendance during the session. In case, a student does not meet this requirement, he/she may be barred from appearing in the exams. Please note and be careful for the next session and onwards.
- Uniform creates a sense of uniformity and belongingness to their Alma Mater. Therefore, students are expected to come to school in neat and proper school uniform as per the prescribed dress code i.e., Girls to tie their hair neatly, boys to have proper trimmed hair. **Students must wear their ID Card every day.**

Please make a new Identity Card in case of loss, change in address and telephone numbers {which will be chargeable}. They should not carry expensive stationery/items to the school.

- **Helmet and Driving License are mandatory for the students commuting by their own two-wheeler.**
- Parents are requested to attend the Open House to interact with their ward's teachers.
- Fill in both the copies of **Pupil's Particulars' sheets** in the **School Almanac** on priority basis. A copy of the same will be retained by the Class Teacher for future reference.
- You are required to use the pages provided in the Dairy for Parent's message, if you wish to send any message to the Teacher/Coordinator.
- **The School Diary should be brought to school daily and on all visiting days to school.**
- Please label your child's belongings with Name, Grade and Division.
- Keep track of the Inter House and Club activities and encourage your ward to participate and engage in the same for overall development.
- **Send only Vegetarian food to school in your child's tiffin.** Encourage your child to develop healthy eating habits by sending at least 1 fruit in his/her tiffin and avoiding junk food for brunch. Students of Primary classes may carry an extra tiffin to school till they get accustomed to the school timings and work duration.
- **Mobile will not be permitted in the school. In case of any emergency, school office phones will be available for use.**
- Our classrooms are equipped with Digital Multimedia which will be used regularly in the teaching process that will enhance the entire learning experience of our students.
- Please check the school website and school social media accounts on a regular basis to stay updated about the school events.
- The school calendar is planned to share the curriculum and activities with the students and parents for each month.
- **We request our parents to take time to encourage reading habit in their ward by motivating the child to read daily at home. Investing 30 minutes in reading everyday will have a huge impact on the child's language and comprehension skills. Reading is the foundation in all subject areas; students who read well perform well in school.**
- The school offers evening games facility to the students i.e. Basketball, Badminton, Taekwondo, Soccer, Lawn Tennis and Skating. For further queries, please feel free to contact Mr. Vinod Sharma at 9352202880.
- You are requested to deposit the fee latest by 10th April, 2023 for this quarter.
- The School Office and Library will remain open on all working days between 9:00am and 1:00pm even during the summer vacation. Kindly return the book in good condition as per the return schedule to avoid any penalty charges.
