#### **Academics and Achievements**

This report showcases not only the achievements and glories of our school but also prompts us to think deeply about areas where we can strengthen ourselves further. We are committed to creating an environment that nurtures young minds, fosters individual thinking, and promotes the holistic development of each child's personality. Excellence in academics is the hallmark of any good institution, and our results prove that our students have made us proud and will continue to do so.

#### SSE & SSCE 2024 Results

Our young Sanskarians achieved a 100% result in the SSE & SSCE 2024 examinations. Their commendable performance, hard work, and enthusiasm have been exemplary.

In CBSE-X, more than 25 students scored above 90 in all five subjects. Aditi Gaur, Shaurya Raj, and Charvi Patel each scored 99 in Social Science. Aditi Gaur also scored 99 in Science, securing the highest percentage of 97.6 among the entire X group, followed by Shaurya Raj with 97%. Over 52 students scored 90+ in English, and 27 students scored 90+ in Mathematics. A remarkable 50 students achieved 90+ in science, and 53 students scored 90+ in Social Science.

The SSCE 2024 results have been remarkable, with a 100% pass rate and more than 100 students scoring above 90. Over 20 students scored above 90 in all five subjects. Krish Narang, Vidhi Bhalothia, Raghav Maheshwari, and Tanisha Jain topped the SSCE 2024 results with scores of 97%, 96.4%, 96%, and 96% respectively. Perfect 100 scores were achieved by Krish Narang, Mahi Khulhari, Mishti Singhal, and Shivanshu Soni in Psychology. Dravya Jain and Krish Narang scored 100 in App Commercial Art, joined by 12 other students scoring 90+ in the same subject.

### **Cambridge Results**

The Cambridge 2024 batch sustained a 100% pass rate. Himaanika Saini, Divyanshi Chauhan, and Kartikya Jangid secured a Grade B with scores of 78, 70, and 70 respectively in English. Five students scored 90+ marks in various subjects, and over 20 students scored more than 80. Hritank Choudhary and Kartikya Jangid earned Grade B with 77 and 84 marks respectively in Mathematics. Kartikya Jangid and Divyanshi Chauhan scored A grades with 80 and 83 marks respectively in Biology, while Himaanika Saini secured a Grade B with 71 marks. More than 50% of students scored more than 70 marks on an average. Kartikya Jangid and Purvansh Kaushik achieved A grades with scores of 96 and 92 respectively, while Divyanshi Chauhan and Poorvi Detha secured Grade B with scores of 83 and 72. Hritank Chaudhary and Nipun Jhalani achieved A grades in Business Studies with scores of 80 and 78 respectively.

#### **IBDP** Results

Sanskar School is proud to announce an outstanding performance in the IBDP 2024 examination, with a 100% pass rate among our students. The highest score in Hindi B was achieved by a student with a grade of 6, equivalent to 87%. Hritik Saxena and Aishwarya Khanna each secured a total of 22-points, placing them among the top performers in the school. Hritik's performance in subjects such as Hindi B and Mathematics Analysis was particularly notable, while Aishwarya's strengths were in English A Language and Literature and Digital Society.
